


## **Internship Opportunities for Undergraduate and Graduate interns**

Students looking for an internship placement in a nonprofit setting may select from any of the following or a combination of them to do their required internship.



- o Providing emotional support members and friends.
- o Providing information to help a survivor understand sexual assault impact, police procedures, the sexual assault examination, legal process, counseling opportunities, and other needed resources.
- Students will have the opportunity to learn various aspects of program administration from research and data development to program design as required by their program. This can include:
  - o Grant research
  - Fundraising
  - o Special event planning/execution
  - o General office needs
- Student must be available during regular office hours, Monday-Friday from 9-5 pm.

- Pass the criminal background check 2.
- Complete DARCC Advocate training 3.
- The Victim Advocate Training Final Exam will be given at the end 4. of training. Those scoring lower than 70% will be required to have further training and re-take the test.
